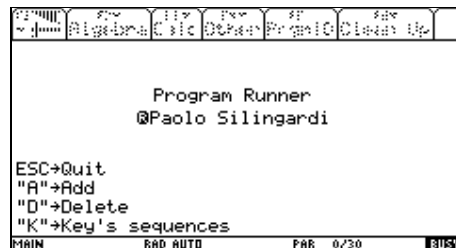


Runner is the faster way to run all your programs with a single key: rename it to 'kdbprgm1-9' and you'll be able to run every program pressing only 3 keys!

Runner is very easy: enter runner() or rename it to kdbprgm1-9 and press only ♦ 1-9; after this you can press immediately another key or key's sequence (2nd + Key, ♦ + Key...) to run immediately the joined program or to Add, Delete, Check a forgotten key's sequence or simply Quit. After two seconds the explanatory screen is displayed but remember: you can use all program functions even before.



Press **A**→ Adds a new program to the list. Enter program name with the correct argument (parenthesis) and the joined key's sequence.

Press **D**→ Deletes a program from the list.

Press **K**→ Displays the key's sequence joined to each program. If a number is displayed you have to check the exact sequence on your manual.

Press **ESC**→ Quit

The list with the programs and the joined keys is stored in the matrix **runpmat**; you can also carefully modify it from the home screen.

This program has been already used many times without problems. If you finds any bug first assure you to have selected the English language in the mode and not to have translated the code with any program. If the problem persists please let me know.

For a better and faster answer please enclose some screenshot of the bug: entered inputs, expected outputs, error messages, erroneous code line, mode setting... it will help me very much!
